Grape Varieties:
40% Alicante Bouschet, 20% Touriga Nacional, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Aragonez

Climate:
Mediterranean, continental climate with mainly warm and dry days

Soils:
Marble, Schist and limestone

Vinification:
Stainless steel tank
Aged partially in French Oak barrels for 12 months (30% new oak, 50% used, 20% vat)

Chemical Analysis:
Alcohol: 14,3%
pH: 3,5
Total Acidity: 5,7 g/dm³
Residual sugar: 1,2 g/dm³

Tone:
Brilliant garnet color

Nose:
Appealing and complex bouquet, with notes of secondary fruit adding depth and complexity to the wine.

Palate:
Velvety tannins with an attractive mouthfeel of ripe fruit. With bright acidity, ends fresh and elegantly.

Food Pairing:
The elegant yet bold character invites to a pair with something from the grill.

15°C-18°C
