Grape Varieties:

70% Alicante Bouschet, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon 5% Touriga Nacional

Climate:

Mediterranean, continental climate with mainly warm and dry days

Soils:

Marble, Schist and limestone

Vinification:

Stainless steel tank

Aged 15 to 18 months in french oak barrels (30% new oak)

Chemical Analysis:

Alcohol: 13,6%

pH: 3,48

Total Acidity: 5,8 g/dm³ Residual sugar: 0,9 g/dm³

Tone:

Deep garnet color

Nose:

Mineral and complex with hints of dark berries, herbs and spices.

Palate:

The mouthfeel is characterized by layered tannins and a cool, fresh marble minerality leading to an elegant finish.

Its complexity invites you to try it with game or something special prepared in the oven.
